Jury process: All work submitted will be reviewed by the event committee. Artisans will be notified by email on or before September 10. With notification of acceptance details will be provided for the event procedures.

Awards: An award of excellence will be awarded to 5 artisans. The award will be acceptance to 2023 Market and no booth fee in 2023.

All artwork must be original, handmade work of the artist. This includes but not limited to fine art drawing, painting, sculpture, mixed media, glass, pottery, photography, jewelry, printmaking, textile, and craft.

The Market reserves the right to photograph for promotional purposes only, any artwork or participants in the Carriage Factory Art Market.

All artisans are responsible for tents (tents are required), tables, chairs, etc. Tents must be weighted down, stakes will not be allowed. All displays and decorations must remain within the artisans tent and the 10x10 space.

All responsibility and liability for insuring artwork is the artisans. The Carriage Factory Art Gallery and sponsors are not liable for theft, damage, or loss of property or personal injury.

Kansas Sales Tax information will be provided to those who do not have a sales tax number the day of the event. Artists are responsible for including and remitting sales tax due on all sales to the Kansas Department of Revenue.

Booth fee;

Outdoor 10x10 booth fee: \$40 (\$10 application fee is applied to total booth fee)

Indoor 10x10 booth fee: \$60 (limited space, first come first served, \$10 application fee is applied to total booth fee)
